DOG ELIGIBLE TO ENTER

This trial is open to all dogs SIX (6) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP), an AKC Canine Partners listing number or approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds are eligible to participate. Dogs with a Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or an AKC Canine Partners listing number must be spayed or neutered in order to compete.

Condition of the Dog. Dogs with physical challenges(including amputees) are eligible to participate provided that, in the opinion of the judge, they display no signs of physical discomfort and can safely complete the search. Dogs with bandages, sutures, or visible wounds are not eligible. Deaf dogs and blind dogs are allowed to enter. Dogs that are both deaf and blind are able to participate so long as the handler is in control of the dog at all times, the dog can complete the requirements of the class, and the dog does not appear to be under undue stress in the opinion of the judge.

No entries will be accepted by phone, email, fax, or hand delivery. Express mail entries must include the signature waiver allowing them to be left at the secretary's address - signature required entries will be rejected. UPS and FedEx entries will not be accepted as they cannot deliver to a PO box.

Illegible entries will not be processed and will be shredded. Returned/bounced checks do not constitute a valid entry and will incur \$50.00 collection fee.

Entries not admitted to the trial and withdrawn entries will be shredded; not be returned to the exhibitor. If you want your payment method returned in the event of withdrawal, please include a self addressed, stamped envelope with your entry!

WAIT LIST INFORMATION

A wait list of 50 runs per trial will be maintained until the wait list closing date listed on page 1, after which time, no changes, alterations, substitutions, or backfills will be made to the trial entry list. Any runs not admitted to the trial by the Wait List Close Date above will be refunded.

CLOSING DATE. No entries may be withdrawn with a refund after closing. All entries must be received by trial closing. If a withdrawn entry is replaced by a wait listed entry, a full refund will be issued for the withdrawn entry. Any wait listed entry that does not move off the wait list into the trial will receive a full refund. If you do not wish to commit to a run you must withdraw from the wait list before trial closing.

Withdraw/Wait List updates will conclude April 3rd, 2026, 5 pm.

STAGING AREA, HANDLER'S BRIEFING, AND WARM-UP INFORMATION

Staging Area will be out of view of search area(s). Staging area will include crating, warm-up and waiting area, as well as the secretary table for check-ins and posting of running order and results.

The **Handler's Briefing** will take place in view of the search area prior to the start of each class, after the hide(s) have been set and after the Demo Dog has run. In the Handler's Briefing the judge will explain if there's an off-leash option, number of hides, maximum height of hides and maximum time for the search. **NO DOGS** are to be present during the Handler's Briefing.

Warm-up area: The club shall designate a warm-up area. One labeled container per target odor being used in the trial on that day will be placed in the warm-up area. This will allow handler-dog teams to prepare themselves for the search prior to their run. Each team should limit their warm-up to two minutes or less so that others may be able to use the warm-up area as well. Clubs may also place blank containers.

SEARCH AREA AND RING CONDITIONS

Search areas may be of any shape, and of the size specified in the Regulations for each class.

Search Area Conditions: Searches may be indoors, on matted, carpeted, concreted, or tiled surfaces, or outdoors on grass, gravel, earth, concrete, or asphalt surfaces. Tarps may be used on the floor for buried.

Search Area Sizes will be as specified in AKC Scent Work regulations.

ADDITIONAL SITE INFORMATION

Trial Site: It is not appropriate to scout the trial location prior to the trial date. Many search locations are real-life environments and such visits may risk the host losing the opportunity to use the location in the future. This is a private property.

Potty Area & Restrooms: Designated potty areas will be pointed out during the Handler Briefing. The restroom facilities for exhibitors are located in the training center. There will be intervals where the restroom will not be available. Please relieve your dogs in marked areas outside and be careful to not allow your dog to mark or urinate inside or on the buildings, trash cans and cars nearby. Trash cans are placed throughout the grounds-please use them.

Possession of Odors and Training: Chapter 5. Section 35 of the Scent Work Regulations state "No person other than those engaged in the administration of a trial shall be in possession of any target odor when on the trial grounds. There shall be no training on the grounds of the AKC Scent Work trial, other than the designated warm-up area".

Spectator Area: The search areas will be tight due to AKC square footage requirements. Spectators will be extremely limited and left to the discretion of the judge.

Crating space will be available inside for entered dogs and well behaved non-entered dogs on a case by case basis - please email the trial chair and secretary to request unentered dog admittance. **The event site requires a clean mat to be placed on the floor underneath your crates.** Dogs must be crated. No loose dogs or x-pens allowed. Empty Crates may be left overnight; however, ODTC will not be responsible for any lost or damaged items left at the show site. **DOGS MUST BE CRATED, NO LOOSE DOGS OR XPENS ALLOWED.**

Parking: Parking at the training center is limited. No overnight RV parking.

Smoking and Alcohol: The training center is a smoke and alcohol-free area. Step 20' away from the entrance doors to smoke. Dispose of butts properly. Avoid smoking anywhere near outdoor search areas.

Food and Concessions: Exhibitors should bring their own lunch, snacks, and beverages if desired. There are a few restaurants and convenience stores within reasonable driving distance.

While not actively searching, dogs MUST be on a fixed length 6' or shorter leash, INCLUDING entering and exiting search areas in order to avoid dog to dog contact. Flexi leads are not permitted on trial grounds with the exception of inside the search area ONLY. Your dog may NOT leave the search area on a retractable leash of any kind.

RIBBONS, AWARDS, AND PRIZES

Placement ribbons will be awarded in each class as follows:

First Place	Blue
Second Place	Red
Third Place	Yellow
Fourth Place	White
Qualifying Score	Dark Green

A New Title rosette will be awarded to all dog and handler teams finishing a title.

Super Sniffer: Teams must qualify in all odor division elements, regardless of level split, in a single trial. Super Sniffer award is a scent work themed item such as a sticker or magnet, as available, and a flat ribbon. Sponsored by Hey Jude Creative.

Ribbons and prizes will not be mailed.

HIGH IN TRIAL

HIT: Teams must enter and qualify in all standard titling elements offered within the same level. HIT is awarded to the team with the fewest faults and fastest cumulative time. HIT is awarded in each level. Novice A and B are scored together and only one HIT will be awarded for Novice.

High in Trial cannot be scored before all classes in a given level are completed.

Teams winning HIT will earn a Rosette from ODTC and prize from Hey Jude Creative

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

SAFETY, BEHAVIOR AND LIABILITY

The safety of the dog is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all searches safely. **It is expressly understood** that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create an unnecessary disturbance or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the trial committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made. The Orlando Dog Training Club and its agents, employees, etc., will assume no responsibilities for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors or handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children. The Orlando Dog Training Club reserves the right to decline entries for cause and may remove any dog on account of aggression. No one shall have any recourse or claim against the Orlando Dog Training Club or any official thereof.

Collars, Leashes and Harnesses: **While not actively searching, dogs MUST be on a fixed length 6' or shorter leash, INCLUDING entering and exiting search areas in order to avoid dog to dog contact.** During searches, dogs must wear a properly fitted collar or harness approved by the judge. A wearable camera such as a Go Pro may be mounted to the dog's harness, if desired. Leashes may be of any length and/or retractable. The leash should be made of plain, pliable material.

All dogs must be on leash at all times, and retractable leashes may not be used when on trial grounds (except during judged searches). Dogs must enter and exit the search area with the leash attached to the collar or harness, including when waiting in the search area before and after

the search. An off-leash option may be offered at the discretion of the judge, only if the area is completely enclosed.

REFUNDS

No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee. No entry fee will be refunded in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by the action of the Trial Committee. Dogs pulled after closing because of injury or other medical condition are not eligible for a refund.

Bitches in season will be refunded the full entry fee. Notification in writing must be given to the trial secretary no later than one half hour prior to the start of the first class of the day of the trial.

Refunds will be mailed by the club after the trial concludes. ODTC does not make refunds under \$10 - check your entry fees!

Entries not admitted to the trial and withdrawn entries will be shredded, not be returned to the exhibitor.

Requests for returned checks and money orders must be made in writing to the Trial Secretary by email before the closing date and a self addressed and stamped envelope must be provided by the exhibitor.

RINGSIDE

Judges are not required to wait for dogs. The Owner of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at the search area when it is to be judged. The Club has no responsibility to provide service through a public address system or stewards or runners for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought into the ring when required.

EXHIBITOR CHECK-IN: Once the procedure for check-in is determined all exhibitors will be notified by email in the official welcome letter.

Exhibitors MUST check-in EACH day they are entered.
Claims will be arbitrated as set forth on the Official AKC Entry Form for this event.

"Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations." Additionally, clubs should include any specific local or state health requirements; for example, proof of rabies vaccination.

DIRECTIONS TO THE TRIAL SITE - 6357 ALL AMERICAN BLVD

From the South on I-4: Heading East (North) on I4, Exit at Lee Road and head West (left) turn Right on Edgewater Drive, Right at the light onto All American Blvd. Building will be on the right on the curve.

From North of Orlando on I-4: Heading West (south) on I4 Exit at Lee Road and head West (right) turn Right on Edgewater Drive, Right at the light onto All American Blvd. Building will be on the right on the curve.

From South Orlando using 441/Orange Blossom Trail: Head north, cross over Lee Road, turn Right on All American Blvd., cross over Edgewater Drive at the light and building will be on the right.

From North Orlando using 441/Orange Blossom Trail: Head south, turn Left on All American Blvd., cross over Edgewater Drive at the light and building will be on the right.

From North Orlando, Maitland, Altamonte Springs etc.: Using Maitland Blvd from either direction, head South on 434 (Forest City Road) Turn Right on All American Blvd. Building will be on your left.

Entry FAQs

Should I enter Novice A or B?

Novice A is for beginners, B is for dogs that have titled in AKC Scent Work OR a comparable event in another venue OR handlers who are professional K9 handlers OR Judges. Obedience, Rally, Agility, etc. titles do not factor into B status.

If you title in Novice and would like to STAY in Novice for Elite legs, you MUST move to Novice B.

How many times can I enter?

You can enter as many elements as you want. You may enter up to 2 levels in the same element per trial event. If you enter more than 2 levels, the highest 2 will be counted.

How do I get High in Trial?

To be eligible for High In Trial you must enter all offered elements in the same level AND qualify in ALL elements. The HIT is the team with the fewest faults in the fastest cumulative time. Novice A and B are scored as one class for HIT.

What's a Super Sniffer and how do I win it?

To be eligible for Super Sniffer you must enter all offered elements in any level combination AND qualify in ALL elements. Essentially - you must qualify in all offered odor classes offered for that trial, regardless of level.

What time will I run?

Tentative class counts and a schedule will be emailed out after wait list closing. These times are estimates and provided as a courtesy - they are not guaranteed times.

In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim of loss, injury or damage to this dog.
