Ring conflicts will be accommodated as best as possible by moving missing exhibitors to the end of the run order before closing the class, but we cannot hold any class for conflicted and absent exhibitors. You MUST check in prior to last call for each class to run.

*\*this schedule may adjust depending on entry and space available and will be communicated via email to entered and wait listed exhibitors\**

**Move-ups will be offered. Move-ups for the following day must be received by the trial secretary before the last class of the day is completed. You cannot move from Master into Detective. Detective is it's own entry.**

### DOG ELIGIBLE TO ENTER

This trial is open to all dogs SIX (6) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP), an AKC Canine Partners listing number or approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds are eligible to participate. Dogs with a Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or an AKC Canine Partners listing number must be spayed or neutered in order to compete.

**Condition of the Dog.** Dogs with physical challenges(including amputees) are eligible to participate provided that, in the opinion of the judge, they display no signs of physical discomfort and can safely complete the search. Dogs with bandages, sutures, or visible wounds are not eligible. Deaf dogs and blind dogs are allowed to enter. Dogs that are both deaf and blind are able to participate so long as the handler is in control of the dog at all times, the dog can complete the requirements of the class, and the dog does not appear to be under undue stress in the opinion of the judge.

## ENTRY FEES

\*an entry is defined as a single run by a single dog, in a single class.

## WAIT LIST INFORMATION

A wait list of 50 runs per trial will be maintained until the wait list closing date listed on page 1, after which time, no changes, alterations, substitutions, or backfills will be made to the trial entry list. Any runs not admitted to the trial by the Wait List Close Date above will be refunded.

**CLOSING DATE.** No entries may be withdrawn with a refund after closing. All entries must be received by trial closing. If a withdrawn entry is replaced by a wait listed entry, a full refund will be issued for the withdrawn entry. Any wait listed entry that does not move off the wait list into the trial will receive a full refund. If you do not wish to commit to a run you must withdraw from the wait list before trial closing.

**Withdraw/Wait List updates will conclude February 13, 2023, 12 noon.**

## STAGING AREA, HANDLER'S BRIEFING, AND WARM-UP INFORMATION

**Staging Area** will be out of view of search area(s). Staging area will include crating, warm-up and waiting area, as well as the secretary table for check-ins and posting of running order and results.

The **Handler's Briefing** will take place in view of the search area prior to the start of each class, after the hide(s) have been set and after the Demo Dog has run. In the Handler's Briefing the judge will explain if there's an off-leash option, number of hides, maximum height of hides and maximum time for the search. **NO DOGS** are to be present during the Handler's Briefing.

**Warm-up area:** The club shall designate a warm-up area. One labeled container per target odor being used in the trial on that day will be placed in the warm-up area. This will allow handler-dog teams to prepare themselves for the search prior to their run. Each team should limit their warm-up to two minutes or less so that others may be able to use the warm-up area as well. Clubs may also place blank containers.

## SEARCH AREA AND RING CONDITIONS

Search areas may be of any shape, and of the size specified in the Regulations for each class.

**Search Area Conditions:** Searches may be indoors, on matted, carpeted, or tiled surfaces, or outdoors on grass, gravel, earth, concrete, or asphalt surfaces.

**Search Area Sizes** will be as specified in the *Regulations for AKC Scent Work*.

## ADDITIONAL SITE INFORMATION

**Trial Site.** It is not appropriate to scout the trial location prior to the trial date. Many search locations are real-life environments and such visits may risk the host losing the opportunity to use the location in the future.

**Possession of Odors and Training.** Chapter 5. Section 35 of the Scent Work Regulations state "No person other than those engaged in the administration of a trial shall be in possession of any target odor when on the trial grounds. There shall be no training on the grounds of the AKC Scent Work trial, other than the designated warm-up area".

**Spectator Area.** Spectators are encouraged. Any person not handling a dog in the current class, or any person who has already completed their run in the class may choose to watch the search from the spectator area. Handlers may not watch other exhibitors from their class prior to their run except in the case of Handler Discrimination classes. No one outside the search area may assist the handler or disclose the location of the hide.

**Crating space** Crating is available across from the event site in Building B (grooming) and on the deck space outside under shade next to the event building.

Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dog(s). Any exhibitor failing to do so may be excused without benefit of refund if the Event Committee deems the exhibitor to be in violation of this requirement. Cleaning supplies and disposal sites will be available at various locations around the show grounds.

**While not actively searching, dogs MUST be on a fixed length 6' or shorter leash, INCLUDING entering and exiting search areas in order to avoid dog to dog contact. Flexi leads are not permitted on trial grounds with the exception of inside the search area ONLY. Your dog may NOT leave the search area on a retractable leash of any kind.**

## RIBBONS, AWARDS, AND PRIZES

Placement ribbons will be awarded in each class as follows:

First Place . . . . .	Blue
Second Place . . . . .	Red
Third Place . . . . .	Yellow
Fourth Place . . . . .	White
Qualifying Score . . . . .	Dark Green

A **New Title** rosette will be awarded to all dog and handler teams finishing a title.

**Super Sniffer:** Teams must qualify in all odor division elements, regardless of level split, in a single trial. Each team will receive a ribbon and small prize sponsored by Hey Jude Creative.

Ribbons and prizes will not be mailed.

## HIGH IN TRIAL & HIGH COMBINED DIVISION

HIT: Teams must enter and qualify in all standard tilting elements offered within the same level. HIT is awarded to the team with the fewest faults and fastest cumulative time.

HIT is awarded in each level. Novice A and B are scored together and only one HIT will be awarded for Novice.

Teams winning HIT will earn a Rosette from LWHKC and prize provided by Hey Jude Creative.

## NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

### SAFETY, BEHAVIOR AND LIABILITY

**The safety of the dog** is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all searches safely. **It is expressly understood** that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create an unnecessary disturbance or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the trial committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made. The Lakeland Winter Haven Kennel Club, Inc. and its agents, employees, etc., will assume no responsibilities for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors or handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children. The Lakeland Winter Haven Kennel Club, Inc. reserves the right to decline entries for cause and may remove any dog on account of aggression. No one shall have any recourse or claim against the Lakeland Winter Haven Kennel Club, Inc. or any official thereof.

**Collars, Leashes and Harnesses:** **While not actively searching, dogs MUST be on a fixed length 6' or shorter leash, INCLUDING entering and exiting search areas in order to avoid dog to dog contact.** During searches, dogs must wear a properly fitted collar or harness approved by the judge. A wearable camera such as a Go Pro may be mounted to the dog's harness, if desired. Leashes may be of any length and/or retractable. The leash should be made of plain, pliable material.

**All dogs must be on leash at all times**, and retractable leashes may not be used when on trial

grounds (except during judged searches). Dogs must enter and exit the search area with the leash attached to the collar or harness, including when waiting in the search area before and after the search. An off-leash option may be offered at the discretion of the judge, only if the area is completely enclosed.

## REFUNDS

**No entry fee will be refunded** if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee. No entry fee will be refunded in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by the action of the Trial Committee. Dogs pulled after closing because of injury or other medical condition are not eligible for a refund.

**Bitches in season** will be refunded the full entry fee. Notification in writing must be given to the trial secretary no later than one half hour prior to the start of the first class of the day of the trial.

**Refunds due prior to closing** will be processed weekly. Entries paid by check will be shredded NOT returned. Online entries will be refunded via PayPal, less applicable PayPal fees.

**WITHDRAWALS MADE AFTER CLOSING** that are legally eligible for refund as described above will be processed after the trial has concluded. Refunds due by check will be sent within 3 weeks of the trial date. Refunds for online entries will be processed within 1 week after the trial date.

**Entries not admitted to the trial and withdrawn entries will be shredded, not be returned to the exhibitor.**

**Requests for returned checks must be made in writing to the Trial Secretary by email before the closing date and a self addressed and stamped envelope must be provided by the exhibitor.**

## RINGSIDE

**Judges are not required to wait for dogs.** The Owner of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at the search area when it is to be judged. The Club has no responsibility to provide service through a public address system or stewards or runners for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought into the ring when required.

**EXHIBITOR CHECK-IN:** At check-in you will receive your armband number. Check In will be at the show site starting an hour before the trial start.

**Please observe social distancing while spectating.**

*Exhibitors MUST check-in EACH day they are entered.  
Claims will be arbitrated as set forth on the Official AKC Entry Form for this event.*

*"Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations." Additionally, clubs should include any specific local or state health requirements; for example, proof of rabies vaccination.*

# ENTRY FAQs

## Should I enter Novice A or B?

Novice A is for beginners, B is for dogs that have titled in AKC Scent Work OR a comparable event in another venue OR handlers who are professional K9 handlers OR Judges. Obedience, Rally, Agility, etc. titles do not factor into B status.

If you title in Novice and would like to STAY in Novice for Elite legs, you MUST move to Novice B.

## How many times can I enter?

You can enter as many elements as you want. You may enter up to 2 levels in the same element. If you enter more than 2 levels, the highest 2 will be counted.

## How do I get High in Trial?

To be eligible for High In Trial you must enter all offered elements in the same level AND qualify in ALL elements. The HIT is the team with the fewest faults in the fastest cumulative time. Novice A and B are scored as one class for HIT.

## What's a Super Sniffer and how do I win it?

To be eligible for Super Sniffer you must enter all offered elements in any level combination AND qualify in ALL elements. Essentially - you must qualify in all offered odor classes offered for that trial, regardless of level.

## What if I'm entered in Conformation/Rally/Dock Diving/Obedience/Barn Hunt/FastCat/etc?

We will do our best to accommodate conflicts, however, we cannot hold the trial for absent exhibitors. Check-in in the morning and notate C for conflict at check-in next to your dog's name. If you are not checked in we will not wait for you. We will move you to the **end** of the run order if you are not present for your turn. At the end of the class, we will do a final call for checked in exhibitors and wait no longer than 5 minutes for and final call exhibitors.

## What time will I run?

Tentative class counts and a schedule will be emailed out after waitlist closing. These times are estimates and provided as a courtesy - they are not guaranteed times.

### AGREEMENT

I (we) agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem sufficient. I (we) certify and represent that the dog entered is not a hazard to persons or other dogs. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim of loss, injury or damage to this dog.

Additionally, I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify, defend and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting therefrom, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves), or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, however such, injuries death or property damage may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may be alleged to have been caused by the negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees, agents, or any other person.
